

STARTUP SEQUENCE

Suzuki Swift

1. PREPARE to START

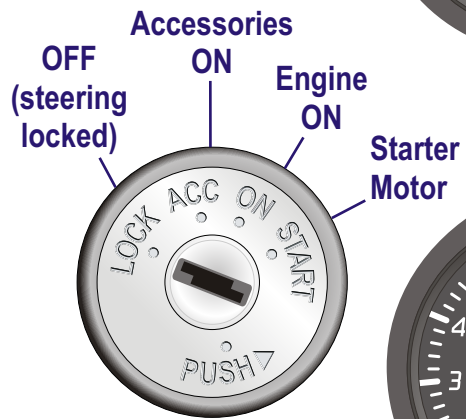
Check handbrake is ON,
Apply the FOOT BRAKE
Clutch DOWN
Select NEUTRAL.

NOTE:

If re-starting "in traffic" after stalling,
simply CLUTCH DOWN and START.



(1) BEFORE STARTING



CAUTION: If the key won't turn,
DON'T FORCE IT
you could easily break it!
It could be the STEERING LOCK -
turn or rock the wheel a little,
and try again.

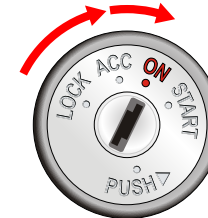
To REMOVE THE KEY, first push in
while it turning anticlockwise ↺

(2) IGNITION turned ON



2. TURN IGNITION ON

Turn ignition ON (2 clicks)
Check WARNING LIGHTS
for correct functioning



3. START ENGINE

START engine
(let go of key when engine fires)
Check WARNING LIGHTS
& GAUGES



(3) ENGINE RUNNING
